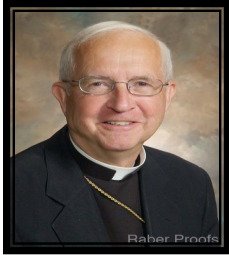

## Confess

Focusing on the image of Jesus on the cross should remind us of how much God loves each of us, and the horrible price of our sins. Think of the words that Jesus spoke from the cross:

“ Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do” (Lk.23:34), expressing forgiveness.

“ Father, into thy hands I commit my spirit!” ( Lk:23:46),proclaiming trust in God.

If we want to get more out of the Mass, we need to be humble: we realize how we fail to live up to the great gift of God’s love we have been given. We confess any serious sins in the Sacrament of Reconciliation before coming to Mass, and we place all of our trust in God’s mercy and love when we publicly proclaim at the Eucharist that we “believe” in Him.

Sin undermines and weakens our communion

not only with the Blessed Trinity but also with one another. Therefore, in order to overcome the damage caused by sin, we are called to daily repentance and no regular participation

in the Sacrament of Penance. Briefly examining our consciences and making an act of contrition, such as before retiring at night, helps guide our repentance and fosters holiness of life. Through these means, not only are the destructive forces of sin vanquished in our lives, but love is once more inflamed for God and for others.

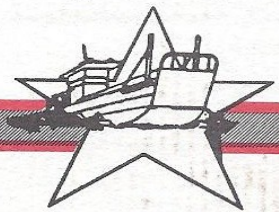
