World Marriage Day will be celebrated in the Diocese, the weekend of February 9-10, 2013. Certificates will be presented to all couples who were married in the Catholic Church 20 years or more, in year ending in a “3” or an “8” (for example -1993=20 years; 1978=35 years), will be presented with a certificate signed by the Bishop on the weekend of February 9-10. Any one married 50 + years (1963 or earlier) are also eligible regardless of the year they were married. Signup sheets are available in the Sacristy. Please sign after Mass today, and the following weeks. No names will be accepted after January 29, 2013.
