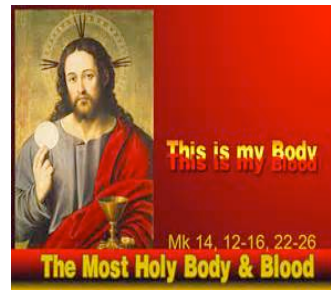


PETER'S PENCE COLLECTION
