Jesus tells the disciples to “give them food yourselves.” But the disciples cannot satisfy the crowds’ hunger until they give Jesus all they have—a meager five loaves and two fish. Jesus blesses these gifts and returns them to the disciples who then have enough to feed the crowds, even with “fragments left over.” It is not the meager resources we have which count, but what Jesus can do with these resources when we give all we have to him. With Jesus’ power and blessing, the disciples (and we) can do what they cannot do on their own.
