The Jews in the gospel think they know Jesus' origins ("the son of Joseph") and, therefore, what he is and is not capable of doing. He commands them to "stop murmuring"—to stop limiting what they know. Only by opening themselves to be "taught by God" can they come to see who Jesus really is ("the living bread . . . from heaven"). Only with this deeper knowledge can they receive the greatest gift he offers—himself, the "living bread".
