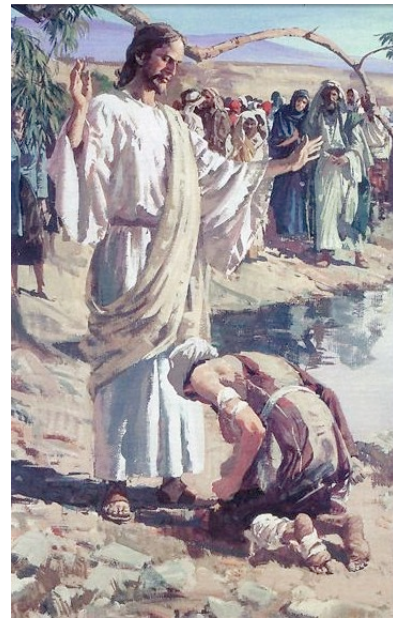


Twenty-Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time October 13, 2013

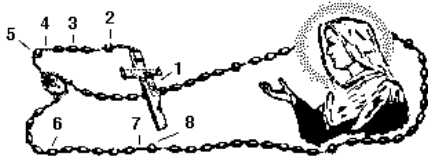
