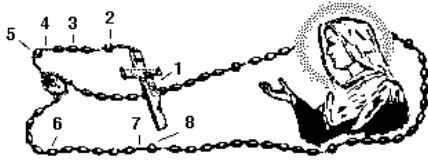
## WORLD MISSION SUNDAY
